munication, and leadership.





NC *FIRST* Robotics is committed to ensuring that every student in North Carolina has access to a high quality *FIRST* experience.




2013-2014 Season Summary


- Over 300 adult mentors and teachers involved with the 44 high-school robotics teams

- Over 150 volunteers gave 5,000+ hours to support NC FIRST Robotics




Students by Economic Tiers
